



## **Chafford Hundred Campus Business & Enterprise College** **Admissions Policy**

***Chafford Hundred Campus is a DfCSF designated Business and Enterprise College. The School intends to admit 180 pupils in September 2011 (subject to change).***

### **Admissions Policy 2011**

Chafford Hundred Campus Business & Enterprise College has a priority admissions area which incorporates the district of Chafford Hundred with the boundaries of:

- To the North: Arterial Road
- To the South: the boundary runs along the centre of London Road from its intersection with Devonshire Road up to the railway bridge near to Angle Road
- To the East: Devonshire Road then along Elizabeth Road to the end of Arterial Road, the properties west of Hogg Lane are included within the campus catchment area.
- To the West: West Thurrock Way joining London Road (South) following the line of the railway up to Arterial Road

In the event of there being more applications for places at Chafford Hundred Campus than there are places available, places will be allocated in the following order of priority.

1. Children in Public Care will automatically be given first consideration above all categories of priority.
2. Pupils resident in the priority admissions area (catchment area) of Chafford Hundred Campus in the following order of priority:
  - a) Pupils who have brothers or sisters attending the school at the date of admission
    - For the purposes of allocating places, the following will be classified as siblings: Full siblings (brother or sister), step siblings, half siblings, and long term foster siblings living at the same address at the same time of application and admission, as a child who attends the Campus in any year group, excluding the final year.
  - b) Pupil's resident within the priority admission area.
3. Residence outside the priority admissions area of Chafford Hundred Campus's School in the following priority:
  - a) Pupils who have brothers or sisters attending the school at the date of admission
    - For the purposes of allocating places, the following will be classified as siblings: Full siblings (brother or sister), step siblings, half siblings, and long term foster siblings living at the same address at the same time of application and admission, as a child who attends the Campus in any year group, excluding the final year.
  - b) Pupils living closest to school
    - Distance from home to school (measured in a straight line in metres by a digital mapping system) will be used to allocate places as a tie breaker in the event of two pupils having equal right to an available place. Straight line measurements from the front door of the home address to the front door of the main school building will be used.

**Note:** Chafford Hundred Campus Business & Enterprise College is the designated Children, Education and Families Resource Base for speech and language children who have a full statement of special needs. These children are not included in the school's published admission limit.
