What is Supporting People?

The Supporting People programme was launched on the 1st April 2003. The programme provides vulnerable people with housing support to enable them to live as independently as possible.

What are housing related support services ?

These are services which have been put into place to help develop and maintain your ability to live independently in accommodation within the community:

- Warden in a sheltered complex
- Support worker visiting your accommodation

Can the Supporting People programme help me?

Supporting People can help a wide range of vulnerable adults, for example:

- Older people needing support
- People with mental health issues
- Homeless families with support needs
- People with drug or alcohol problems
- Teenage Parents
- Ex-offenders
- People at risk of domestic violence
- People with learning difficulties
- People with a physical or sensory disability
- Travellers
- People with HIV or AIDS

What type of help is available?

Here are some examples of what we can help you with:

- Managing debts
- Budgeting
- Accessing Benefits
- Learning about social, domestic and life skills
- Gaining access to employment and training
- Finding somewhere to live and setting up home

Supporting People cannot help with. . .

Personal care services are not included, for example:

- Assistance with washing and dressing
- Administering medication
- Childcare
- Specialist Counselling
