ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with Regulations 24(2), 35 and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (as amended), notice is given that Thurrock Council formally adopted its Core Strategy on the 21st December 2011.

The Thurrock Core Strategy provides the overall vision, objectives and spatial policies for the development of Thurrock up to 2026. It covers the entire Unitary Authority of Thurrock.

An independent Inspector appointed by the Government examined the soundness of the Core Strategy following its submission to the Secretary of State on 30 April 2010. The Inspector's Report dated 9th December 2011 set out binding changes to be made to the submitted Core Strategy.
