STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT ADOPTION STATEMENT

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 The Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004

In accordance with Regulation 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that Thurrock Borough Council formally adopted the Thurrock Borough Council Local Development Framework: Statement of Community Involvement on 27th June 2007.

The Statement of Community Involvement forms part of the Local Development Framework. The Statement of Community Involvement sets out what the Council is seeking to involve the community in; who they are seeking to involve; the methods used to involve the community; and when community involvement will be sought. The Statement of Community Involvement is relevant to all Local Development Documents and planning applications for the whole of the Borough.

Any person aggrieved by the Statement of Community Involvement may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the ground that either the document is not within the power conferred by Part 2 of the Act or that a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with. Any applications must be made no later than 6 weeks after the date of adoption specified above.

In addition, any person aggrieved by the Statement of Community Involvement may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the statement, and any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than 3 months after the date of adoption specified above.
