GATING OF PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 129 BETWEEN COLLEGE AVENUE AND BRADLEIGH AVENUE ORDER 2008
Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980

The Thurrock Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 6th of October 2008 and may be cited as the Thurrock Borough Council Gating of Part of Public Footpath 129 Between College Avenue and Bradleigh Avenue Order 2008.
2. The public right of way along the Highway described in Schedule 1 and shaded yellow on the attached plan shall be restricted to prohibit pedestrian access at all times and the restriction will continue for a period of 12 months upon the implementation of the gates, subject to review by the Council.
3. An alternative route for pedestrian access is described in Schedule 2.
4. Those persons described in Schedule 3 shall be exempt from the provisions of this Order.
5. The Council is hereby authorised to install, operate and maintain barriers/gates at either or both ends of the Highway to enable the enforcement of the restriction. The person responsible for operating and maintaining such barriers is the Council's Head of Strategic Planning and Delivery, Civic Offices, New Road, Grays, Essex RM17 6SL.
6. The conditions set out in Section 129A of the Act have been complied with for the purpose of making this Order.
7. In particular, the conditions set out in Section 129A(3) of the Act have been met, namely, that the Council is satisfied that:
 - (a) premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highway are affected by crime and anti-social behaviour;
 - (b) the existence of the Highway is facilitating the persistent commission of criminal offences and anti-social behaviour; and
 - (c) it is in all the circumstances expedient to make this Order for the purposes of reducing crime and anti-social behaviour.

SCHEDULE 1

Part of Public Footpath 129 between College Avenue and Bradleigh Avenue, Grays, Essex, as shown shaded yellow on the attached plan ("the Highway").

SCHEDULE 2

The alternative route for pedestrians will be via Bradleigh Avenue and College Avenue, Grays, and vice versa, as shown shaded blue on the attached plan.

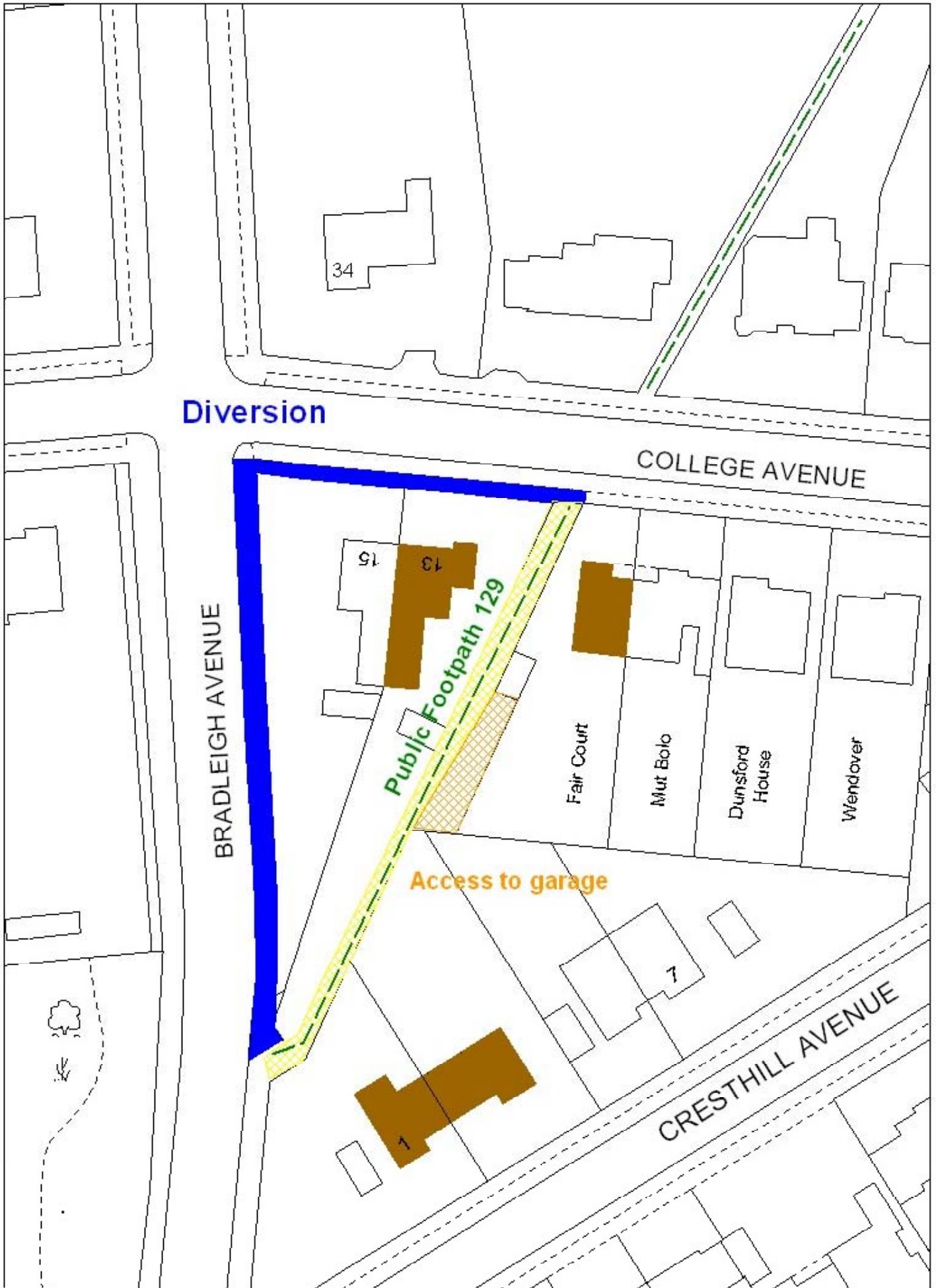
