Thurrock Council – Determined school admission arrangements for September 2025 intakes

All school admission authorities must determine their admission arrangements every year, even if they have not changed from the previous year.

Where changes are proposed to admission arrangements, the admission authority must first consult publicly on those arrangements.

If no changes are made to admission arrangements, they must be consulted on at least once every 7 years.

Admission arrangements consultation and determination timetable
