Infrastructure funding statement 2019/20

1. Introduction

Thurrock Council's infrastructure funding statement sets out this year's income and expenditure relating to the Section 106 (S106) agreements.

All authorities are now required to produce an infrastructure funding statement on an annual basis, as a result of recent changes to government legislation. This represents the borough's first infrastructure funding statement.

This report provides a summary of financial contributions the council has secured through Section 106 agreements from new developments for off-site infrastructure works and affordable housing,

2. Requirements

The matters to be included in the section 106 report for each reported year are as follows:-

- (a) the total amount of money to be provided under any planning obligations which were entered into during the reported year £9,978,281
- (b) the total amount of money under any planning obligations which was received during the reported year £2,733,206
- (c) the total amount of money under any planning obligations which was received before the reported year which has not been allocated by the authority £57,500
- (d) summary details of any non-monetary contributions to be provided under planning obligations which were entered into during the reported year, including details of:
 - i. in relation to affordable housing, the total number of units which will be provided –
 estimate of up to 415 units
 - ii. in relation to educational facilities, the number of school places for pupils which will be provided, and the category of school at which they will be provided **no school places provided instead education contributions provided and a new school**

Land adjacent to A13, A1306 and Purfleet Road, Aveley

Corrective Highways Measures – if unacceptable highway impacts voluntary measures to reduce the number of vehicles entering or leaving or other measures in the Vehicle Monitoring Scheme (VMS), review travel patterns and impose reasonable controls to address unacceptable highway impacts, Signalisation of the access road.

VMS to be submitted for approval and if exceeded implemented corrective measures.

Land adjacent 39 and 41 and to the south of St Johns Road, Chadwell St Mary

Public footpath 116 – to divert and extend.

Development land east of Caspian Way and north and south of London Road, Purfleeton-Thames

Strategic Green Infrastructure Land to be safeguarded.

Car Club scheme to be submitted for approval if the council has not procured a borough wide car club prior to occupation and served notice prior to 50th occupation; implement prior to 100th occupation, provide car spaces and 5 cars following 100th, 200th.

Community Use Facilities to be constructed or procure the construction to shell and core and make facilities available for use and transfer site to the council and/or any other nominated. Community Use Facilities Co-ordinator post to be retained until 1 year after the 600th residential occupation.

Medical Centre or Integrated Medical Centre to be constructed or procure the construction and to be made available by 31/12/2022 or 300th unit.

Early Years facility shell and core to be provided.

Primary School to be constructed or procure the construction to shell and core by the start of academic year 2023/2024 or 300th unit.

Land to rear of Caldwell Road, Kingsman Road and adjacent to A1013, Stanford Road, Stanford-le-Hope

On-Site PROW works with the provision of concrete pads and landing rights for a new 1.5m wide steel bridge linking the internal footway/footpath to Footpath 36 scheme to be submitted and agreed prior to occupation.
