ORDER

NOTICE: The injunction that previously appeared here (and at various sites in Thurrock) has been discharged by the Court and ceased to have effect from 8 February 2024

UPON APPLICATION by the Claimant by Application Notice, dated 8 February 2024, seeking permission, pursuant to CPR 38.2(2)(a)(i), to discontinue the Claim against the 108th Defendant (Persons Unknown)

AND UPON NOTING that the interim injunction of 3 September 2019 (“the Interim Injunction”) remains in force against the 108th Defendant at the time of the Application

AND UPON CONSIDERING the witness statement of Adam Rulewski dated 8 February 2024 in support of the Application

WITHOUT A HEARING IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Discharge of the interim injunction

1. The Interim Injunction is discharged.

2. By 4.30pm on 16 February 2024, the Claimant must publish a copy of this Order by uploading it to the Claimant's dedicated webpage on its website.
3. By 4.30pm on 8 March 2024, the Claimant must remove any and all copies of the Interim Injunction that are displayed at the sites over which injunctive relief was sought and granted.

Service of this Order

4. The Claimant must serve this Order on the 108th Defendant (Persons Unknown) by affixing copies (as opposed to originals) of the Order in a transparent envelope in a prominent place at all sites covered by the Interim Injunction. The Order shall be accompanied by a cover letter explaining that copies of the Order and all documents in the Claim on a dedicated webpage (with the link to be provided in that letter), as well as at the Council Offices at Civic Centre, New Road, Grays RM17 6SL between the hours of 10am and 4pm Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays.
5. The deemed date of service of the Order shall be the day on which service is completed in accordance with the steps set out at Paragraph 4 above.

Discontinuance

6. Upon the Claimant filing a witness statement confirming compliance with Paragraphs 2-4 above, the Claimant has permission to file a notice of discontinuance.

Costs

7. No Order as to costs.
8. This Order has been made without a hearing. Any person affected by this order may apply to the Court within 7 days of the service of this Order to vary or discharge this Order (or so much of it as affects that person).
