## Community Right to Bid

The Community Right to Bid – introduced as part of the Localism Act 2011 – enables certain local voluntary and community organisations to nominate local land or buildings to be included on our list of assets of community value. This entitles them to bid for that asset if it comes up for sale after it has been listed.

This form enables eligible groups to submit an intention to bid upon an asset listed on **Thurrock Council's List of Assets of Community Value** under the Localism Act 2011.

Intentions to bid must be submitted within six weeks of the owner's notification of their intention to sell – dates will be shown on Thurrock Council's List of Assets of Community Value.

Under the Localism Act 2011, only the following organisation types may submit an intention to bid:

- (a) a charity
- (b) a community interest company
- (c) a company limited by guarantee that is non-profit distributing
- (d) an industrial and provident society/community benefit society
