The Claimants seek (i) the adjournment of the final hearing of the Claimants' Claim for final injunctive relief against the Defendants, pending the outcome of the expedited appeal to the Supreme Court in Wolverhampton City Council & Ors v London Gypsies and Travellers & Ors (UKSC 2022/0046), which appeal may dispose of part of these proceedings, (ii) the continuation of the Injunction Order dated 27 May 2022 granted by HHJ Simon (sitting as a Judge of the High Court) (the 'Injunction Order'), pending the outcome of the aforementioned appeal and the final hearing of the Claimants' Claim and (iii) a 12 month extension to the power of arrest contained within the Injunction Order.


