#### The themes for the Spirited Arts competition in 2023 were:



The title I chose is 'green faith green future'. My art piece that I have made for the Spirited Arts competition is titled 'A little bit of hope'. My design illustrates the 'Willow Project', which is a billiondollar project aimed to dump 28 trillion tons of oil into the Antarctic ocean, and by 30 years later, this would leave a catastrophic impact on most of the wildlife there. For example, polar bears, artic foxes, plants, and most marine life.
