Role Title: Youth Club Volunteer

Supported by: Participation Officer, Children's Services

Role Purpose: To volunteer as part of the Youth Work Team. This will involve supporting a variety of youth work sessions (youth clubs, sports and arts sessions) for young people 11-19 years old.

Location: Various – Across Thurrock

Tasks and responsibilities

- To assist in the running of the youth sessions
- Be part of and communicate with the wider youth work team
- To facilitate and participate in games, activities and discussions with young people
- To adhere to any relevant Council policies and procedures e.g. Child Protection – information about these will be given

Skills and experience

- To be willing and able to engage with young people aged 11-19 years
- Be enthusiastic
- Be reliable
- Be patient
- To understand and be committed to equal opportunities

- Evenings (can be flexible around volunteer availability)

- Induction training to welcome volunteers into their role
- Relevant training and development
- On-going support
- Reimbursement of agreed expenses
