Role description

Role title:	Youth Offending Reparation Supervisor Volunteer
Supported by:	Thurrock Youth Offending Team Referral Order Co-ordinator
Role purpose:	To help supervise young offenders working on community based projects such as gardening, painting and graffiti removal. Indirect reparation projects are designed so that young offenders can make amends for the harm they have caused and assist with their reintegration back into the local community.
Location:	Springhouse Road, Corringham.

Tasks and responsibilities

- To help supervise young offenders completing reparation projects.
- To support youth offending staff in the supervision of reparation duties.
- To act in an anti-discriminatory way in all aspects of service delivery.
- To participate in training and supervision.
- To adhere to any relevant Council policies and procedures e.g. Health and Safety

Skills and experience

- Excellent communication skills
- Reliability and commitment
- Empathy with young people
- Ability to maintain confidentiality

Time commitment

- 4 hours slots, usually outside of school/college hours.

Council's commitment

- Induction training, support and guidance.
- Re-imburement of agreed expenses.
