

PUBLIC NOTICE

Victoria Road, Stanford-le-Hope

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic or restriction on roads)

Notice 224 2025

- 1 The Borough Council of Thurrock is satisfied that it is necessary to restrict or prohibit traffic in the above road without delay because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road.
- 2 The Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, has therefore made the following Notice:

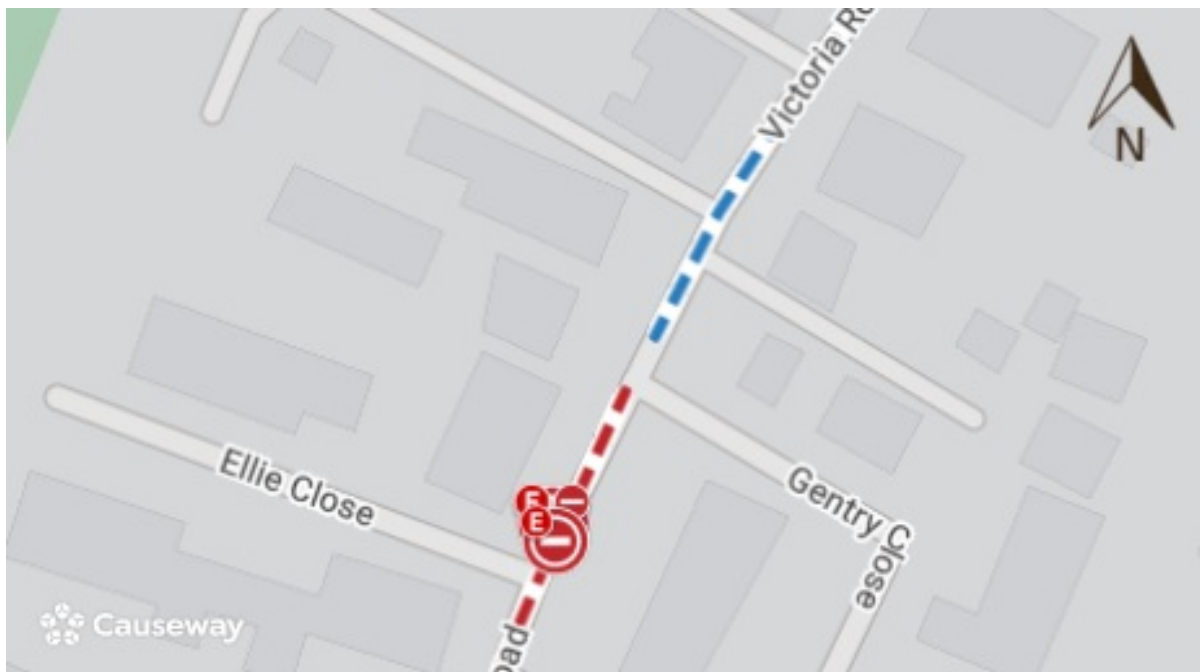
Prohibit any vehicles from travelling along Victoria Road from its junction with Gentry Close for a distance of approx. 40m in a southerly direction.

3. The purpose of the Notice is to enable Cadent to carry out urgent repairs to their apparatus.

- .4. The alternative route for northbound vehicles will be Church Hill, King Street, Southend Road and Victoria Road. For southbound vehicles it will be Southend Road, High Street, Church Hill and Victoria Road. Access will be maintained for residents.

5. The Notice comes into force immediately and will be valid for 21 days. It is however expected that the works will be completed by 31st October 2025. It will apply only on those days and during those times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
