



TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

The Borough of Thurrock (Maple Road, Grays) (Disabled Badge Holders Parking Bay) Order 2026

Made

1st September 2026

Coming into force

15th October 2026

Thurrock Borough Council in exercise of the powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. The Order shall come into operation on the 15th October 2026 and may be cited as The Borough of Thurrock (Maple Road, Grays) (Disabled Badge Holders Parking Bay) Order 2026.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Borough of Thurrock (Stopping, Waiting, Loading and On-street Parking) Order 2017 shall have effect as though:
