## TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

### The Borough of Thurrock (AIP 17 Grays) (20mph Zone) Order 2025

1. Notice is hereby given that Thurrock Borough Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1, 2, 4, 84, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, intends to make the above named Order (“the Proposed Order”).

  - xiii. Culford Road, for its entire length
  - xiv. Gloucester Avenue, for its entire length
  - xv. Harvey, for its entire length
  - xvi. Heath View Gardens, for its entire length
