TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

The Borough of Thurrock (AIP 19 Grays) (20mph Zone) Order 2025

- 1) Notice is hereby given that Thurrock Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby gives notice that they have made the above order on the 10th July 2025, the order will come in to force on the 28th July 2025.
- 2) The general effect of the Order would be to introduce a 20mph Zone at the location(s)/ roads specified below:-

 - iii. Andrea Avenue, For its entire length
 - iv. Antelope Avenue, For its entire length
 - v. Archates Avenue, For its entire length
 - vi. Ark Avenue, For its entire length
 - vii. Armada Court, For its entire length
 - viii. Bradleigh Avenue, For its entire length
 - ix. College Avenue, For its entire length
 - x. Cresthill Avenue, For its entire length
 - xi. Cromwell Road, For its entire length
 - xii. Dell Road, For its entire length
 - xiii. Dexter Close, For its entire length
 - xiv. Dukes Avenue, For its entire length
 - xv. Fairfax Road, For its entire length
 - xvi. Grays End Close, For its entire length
 - xvii. Hampden Road, For its entire length
 - xviii. Hogg Lane, For its entire length (Excluding the A1012 section from Eastern Way to Devonshire Road)
 - xix. Hollis Place, For its entire length
 - xx. Ireton Place, For its entire length
 - xxi. Langthorne Crescent, For its entire length
 - xxii. Lenthall Avenue, For its entire length
 - xxiii. Lisle Place, For its entire length
 - xxiv. Lucas Road, For its entire length
 - xxv. Ludlow Place, For its entire length

 - xxvii. Orchard Drive, For its entire length
 - xxviii. Pym Place, For its entire length
