Rushdon Close - Grays

(Temporary prohibition or restriction on roads)

No. 214 Order 2026

- 1) The Borough Council of Thurrock, in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other powers, has made an Order the effect of which is to: -

Prohibit any vehicle from travelling along Rookery Close and Rushdon Close in their entirety in accordance with Schedule One to the Order.

Prohibit any vehicle from parking during the times of the Order along both kerb lines of Rookery Close and Rushdon Close in their entirety in accordance with Schedule One to the Order.

- 2) The purpose of the Order is to enable Thurrock Council to carry out micro surfacing.
- 3) There is no alternative route, however access will be maintained for residents and businesses at all times.
- 4) The Order will come into force on the 16th September 2026 at 08:00hrs. Works are currently scheduled to take place daily between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00 in accordance with Schedule One to the Order. Exact dates however will always be specified on <https://one.network/?tm=GB152179413> It only applies to those days and times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 5) It is expected that the works will be completed within the above times, however the Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner
- 6) If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the approval of the Secretary of State.
