Rushdon Close and Grays End Close - Grays (Temporary prohibition or restriction on roads)

No. 184 Order 2026

- 1) The Borough Council of Thurrock, in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other powers, has made an Order the effect of which is to: -

Prohibit any vehicle from travelling along Rushdon Close and Grays End Close in their entirety.

- 2) The purpose of the Order is to enable Cadent Gas to carry out gas main replacement works.
- 3) There is no alternative route, however access will be maintained for residents at all times.
- 4) The Order will come into force on the 17th August 2026 at 08:00hrs. Works are currently scheduled to take place daily between 17th August 2026 and 14th September 2026 between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00. Exact dates however will always be specified on <https://one.network/?tm=GB151669227> It only applies to those days and times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 5) It is expected that the works will be completed within the above times, however the Order will continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 6) If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended for a longer period with the approval of the Secretary of State.
