

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## High Road, Fobbing

### (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic or restriction on roads)

#### Notice 179 - 2025

- 1 The Borough Council of Thurrock is satisfied that it is necessary to restrict or prohibit traffic in the above road without delay because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road.
- 2 The Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, has therefore made the following Notice:

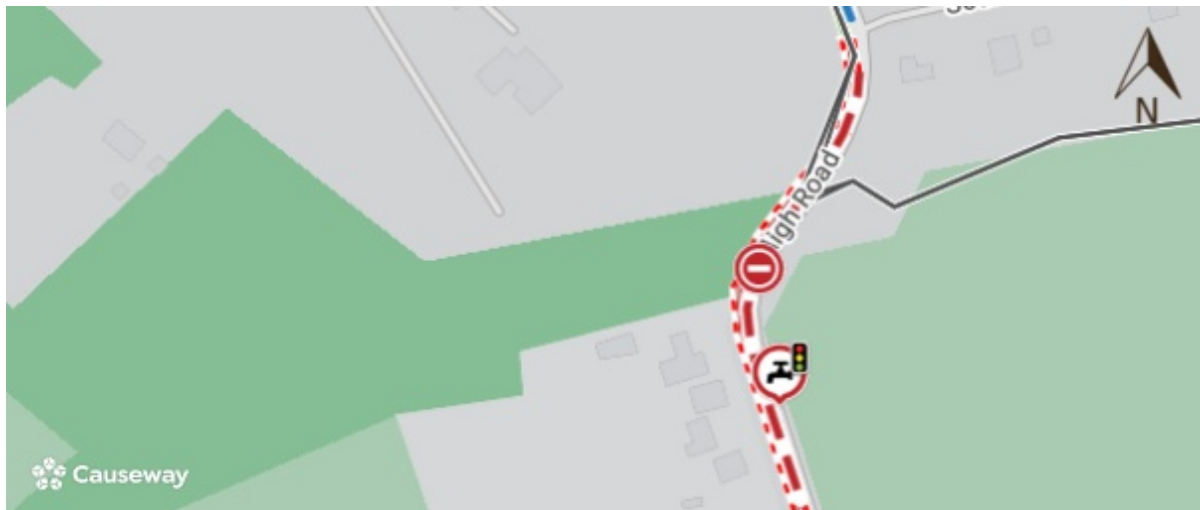
**Prohibit any vehicles from travelling along High Road, Fobbing, from its junction with South Road for a distance of approx 188m in a southerly direction.**

3. The purpose of the Notice is to enable Essex and Suffolk Water to carry out urgent repairs to their apparatus.

4. The alternative route for southbound vehicles will be High Road northbound, Five Bells Roundabout South, Five Bells Road, Link Road From B1420 And Bells Corner Roundabout To Boundary, Bells Corner Roundabout, Southend Road, Lampits Hill, Church Road, Fobbing Road, and Lion Hill and vice versa for northbound vehicles. Access will be maintained for residents.

5. The Notice comes into force immediately 11th September 2025 and will be valid for 21 days. It is however expected that the works will be completed by 18th September 2025. It will apply only on those days and during those times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
