Prince Philip Avenue, Grays

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic or restriction on roads)

Notice 203 2026

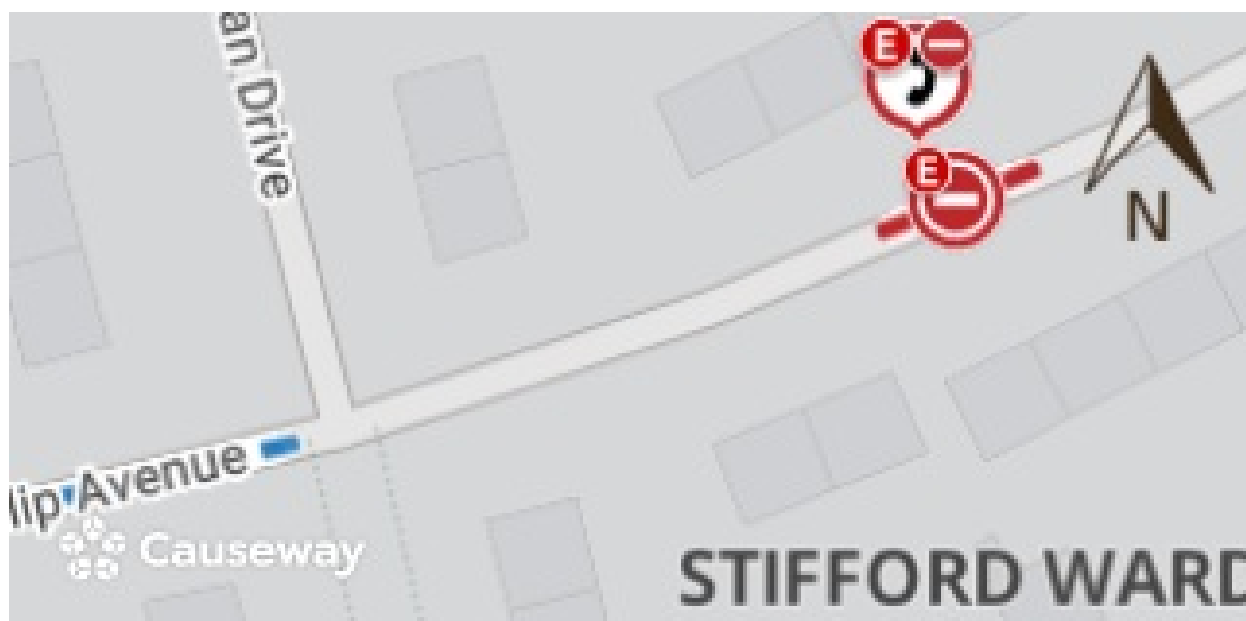
- 1 The Borough Council of Thurrock is satisfied that it is necessary to restrict or prohibit traffic in the above road without delay because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road.
- 2 The Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, has therefore made the following Notice:

Prohibit any vehicles from travelling along Prince Philip Avenue from a point approx. 40m east of its junction with Kingsman Drive for a distance of approx. 20m in a easterly direction.

3. The purpose of the Notice is to enable BT to carry out urgent repairs to their apparatus
4. The alternative route for eastbound vehicles will be Prince Philip Avenue, Gourney Grove and vice versa for westbound vehicles. Access will be maintained for residents.

5. The Notice comes into force immediately immediately and will be valid for 21 days. It is however expected that the works will be completed by 20th August 2026. It will apply only on those days and during those times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
