Temporary Prohibition of Traffic or restriction on roads)

Notice 176 - 2025

- 1 The Borough Council of Thurrock is satisfied that it is necessary to restrict or prohibit traffic in the above road without delay because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road.
- 2 The Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, has therefore made the following Notice:

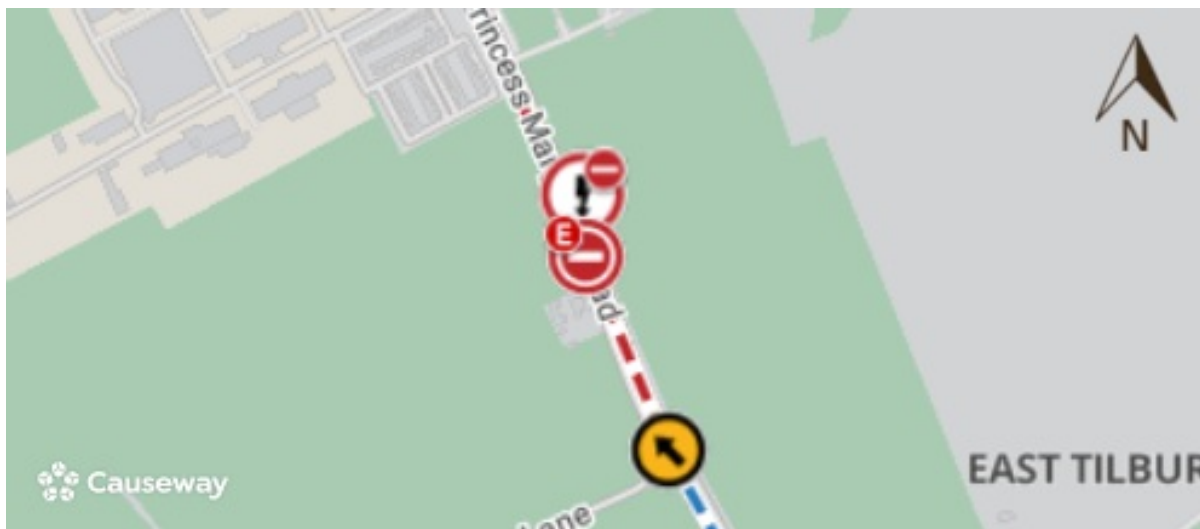
Prohibit any vehicles from travelling along Princess Margaret Road from its junction with Love Lane for a distance of approx 395m in a northerly direction.

Temporarily revoke the 7.5tn weight restriction on Station Road

3. The purpose of the Notice is to enable UK Power Newtorks to carry out urgent repairs to their apparatus.
4. The alternative route is as signposted on site. Access will be maintained for residents.

- The Notice comes into force immediately 8th September 2025 and will be valid for 21 days. It is however expected that the works will be completed by 12th September 2025. It will
5. apply only on those days and during those times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
