

PUBLIC NOTICE

Scratton Road, Stanford le Hope

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic or restriction on roads)

Notice 245 2025

- 1 The Borough Council of Thurrock is satisfied that it is necessary to restrict or prohibit traffic in the above road without delay because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road.
- 2 The Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, has therefore made the following Notice:

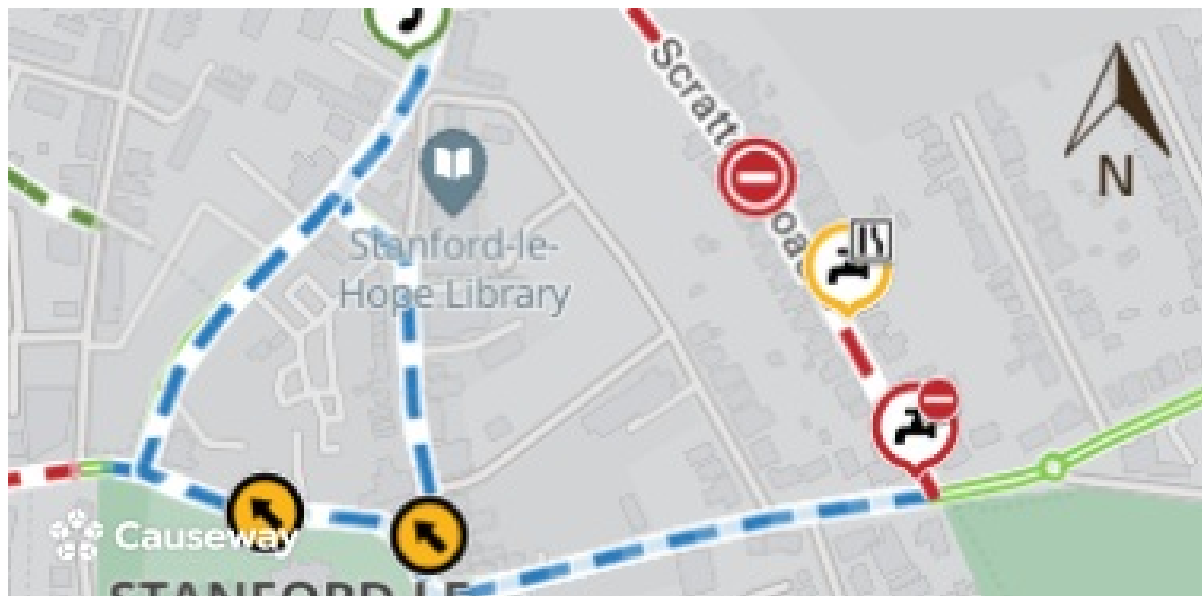
Prohibit any vehicles from travelling along Scratton Road between its junctions with Corringham Road and Hardie Road.

3. The purpose of the Notice is to enable Essex and Suffolk Water to carry out urgent repairs to their apparatus.

4. The alternative route for southbound vehicles will be Southend Road, High Street, The Green, Corringham Road and for northbound vehicles will be Corringham Road, The Green, Church Hill, King Street and Southend Road. Access will be maintained for residents.

5. The Notice comes into force immediately 13th November 2025 and will be valid for 21 days. It is however expected that the works will be completed by 24th November 2025. It will apply only on those days and during those times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
