Stifford Hill, South Ockendon

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic or restriction on roads)

Notice 200 2026

- 1 The Borough Council of Thurrock is satisfied that it is necessary to restrict or prohibit traffic in the above road without delay because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road.
- 2 The Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, has therefore made the following Notice:

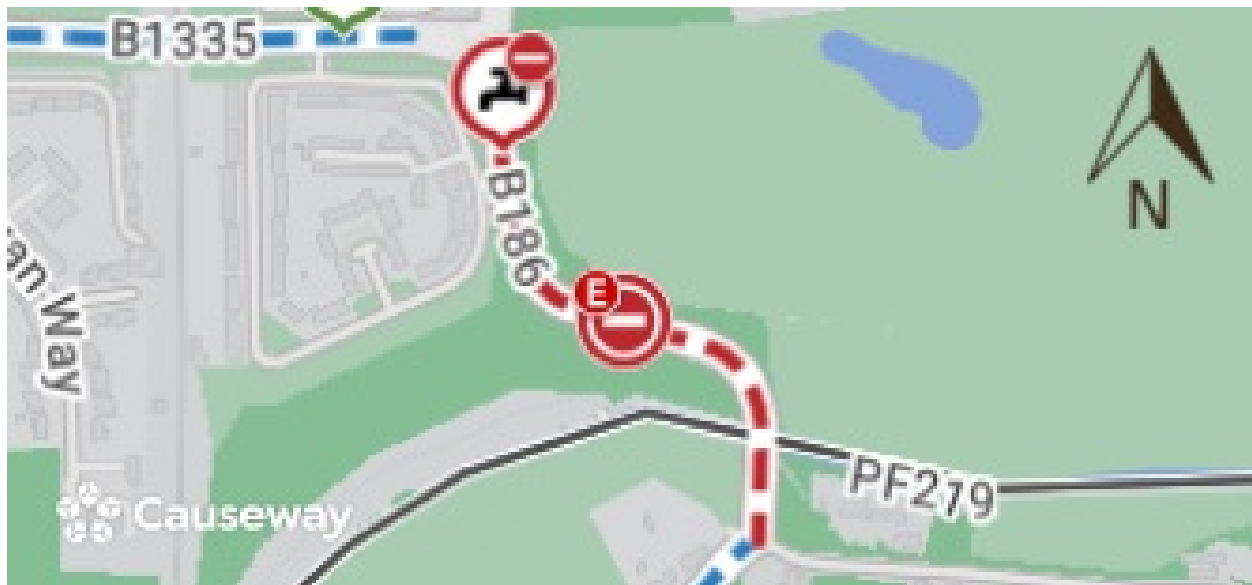
Prohibit any vehicles from travelling along Stifford Hill, South Ockendon, from its junction with Pilgrims Lane and Stifford Road

3. The purpose of the Notice is to enable Essex and Suffolk Water to carry out urgent repairs to their apparatus.

- The alternative route for southbound vehicles will be B1335 Stifford Road, Lance Corporal Nicky Mason Way, Sandy Lane, A1306 New Road, A1306 London Road Aveley, A1306 Arterial Road Purfleet, A1306 Arterial Road West Thurrock, A1306 Arterial Road North Stifford, Pilgrims Lane and vice versa for northbound vehicles. Access will be maintained for residents.

- The Notice comes into force immediately and will be valid for 21 days. It is however expected that the works will be completed by 28th August 2026 . It will apply only on those days and during those times when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
